* - The entry fee must be received before your team is considered entered in this tournament. First payments received, are the first teams entered in the tournament. We have the right to refuse teams for scheduling purposes if the entry fee has not been received by the deadline. **Checks are non-refundable after the deadline date.** If the tournament is cancelled due to weather \$30 of the registration fee will be withheld for administrative costs (ie. – trophies, ribbons, mailings, etc.) the rest of the entry fee will be returned. If the team plays 1 game before a weather-related cancellation, \$60 will be refunded. If the team plays 2 games before a weather-related cancellation, \$30 will be refunded. Admission will be charged at each site but will be good at all gyms. 2 coaches and all players will be admitted free of charge.

Milbank Boys Youth Basketball Tournament Rules

National Federation of State High School rules will be used with the following exceptions:

1. **GAME FORMAT:** Games will have two 15 minute halves. If the score is 10 points or less, the clock will stop during the last 2 minutes of the game.
2. **THREE POINT SHOT:** Will be used where it is properly marked.
3. **OVERTIME:** 2 minutes with the clock stopping on everything and an addition time out plus those not used. A jump ball will begin each overtime period. A maximum of 2 overtime periods. Sudden death overtime in the 3rd overtime period.
4. **TIME OUTS:** Three 45 second timeouts per game.
5. **HALF TIME:** 3 minutes depending on time availability.
6. **GAME TIME IS FOREFEIT TIME:** Teams must have 5 players on the floor to begin a game. A forfeited game counts as one of your three guaranteed games.
7. **PERSONAL FOULS:** Players are allowed 5 fouls. Teams will shoot the bonus on the 7th team foul. On the 10th team foul, teams will shoot 2 shots.
8. **DEFENSES:** 7th and 8th grade may play any time of defense. 4th, 5th, and 6th grade MUST play man to man. 1st violation – warning. 2nd violation – technical. *NOTE: ½ count help defense is not a zone if defensive player has body in proper position to see man they are guarding and the ball. Zone should be called if defensive player has back turned on man they are guarding. Double team is not a zone if offense presents ball in another defensive player’s area. Full Court: common sense must prevail! If teams are in transition and offense dribbles ball off a foot or throws a wild pass the defense may gain possession as there is not pressing intent.*
9. **PRESSING:** Full court pressing is allowed for 7th and 8th grade. 4th, 5th, and 6th may press the last 2 minutes of the game. When one team is leading by 10 or more point, that team cannot full court press
10. **SUBSTITUTION:** Free substitution is not allowed. Players must report to scorer’s table and wait for a dead ball situation & referees to beckon them in.
11. **BASKETBALLS:** Intermediate size ball will be used for all 4th, 5th, 6th, and 7th grade boys. Regulation basketballs will be used for the 8th grade boys.
12. **CONDUCT:** Players and coaches should decisions of the officials. If a player or coach receives a technical foul because of their conduct, they will be banished from the game. A second technical foul will result in their banishment from the tournament.
13. **ELIGIBILITY:** Players must compete in their own grade classifications with the exception that players in a lower grade may participate in an older division. Players from different schools may play together.
14. **UNIFORMS:** All teams must have uniform shirts with visible numbers.
15. **ROSTERS:** Roster changes will not be allowed after your first game has started. Make sure all players are listed in the official scorebook of the first game. This roster will be followed for all other games. All players must have parent’s signatures prior to playing.
16. **SCHEDULE:** Teams should report to their gyms at least 30 minutes before their scheduled game time. The first round of tournament games may be as early as 8am depending on the number of teams entered. After the 1st round of games are completed, games will move along and may start before the scheduled start time. Be aware and available. Due to limited time and gym space, we work hard to keep the tournament moving along smoothly. **ALL TEAMS MUST BE ON TIME.**
17. **NO PROTEST:** The official’s decisions are final. Referees are VOLUNTEERS. **PLEASE BE COURTEOUS! WE CAN NOT RUN A TOURNAMENT WITHOUT THEM!**

Other Tournament Information

- Trophies will be given to 1st place team members, medals give to 2nd place team members.
- There will be two sportsmanship medals given at the conclusion of each game, for one player from each team. Winner will be decided on by the opposite teams' coach and presented by the referees. Coaches please assist with this decision and let the official know if your winner has already received this award from a previous game.
- Admission at all locations will be \$5 for adults with kids free (17 and under).
- Games will be played at Koch Elementary, Milbank High School and Unity Square.
- Concessions will be available throughout the day at all 3 locations.
- Monies earned through the tournament go to fund our local organization.
- Please no coolers allowed in gyms.
